DUBBO CITY AMATEUR SWIMMING CLUB OFFICIAL CLUB RECORDS

Club record attempts need not be swum on a club championship night to stand as official records. If a swimmer feels that they are capable of breaking a record then they are to inform the marshall/starter who will then allocate two time keepers to that lane. The swim must be in the stroke allocated for that night. Swimmers wishing to attempt records in a distance not swam in the time trial programme may do so with the permission of the Club President & Race Secretary.

If a child breaks a club record at a carnival they are to obtain the signature of the official timekeeper of the host club or the signatures of two Dubbo City members attending the carnival (a copy of the form is available at the back of this booklet or from the Race Secretary).

To claim a record swimmers should fill out the required form and give it to the Club President or the Race Secretary who will arrange for the record to be updated and award the swimmer \$20.00.

Swimmers are able to update a record if they swim a faster time but the \$20 will only be awarded once.

All record times should be checked with the Club President or Race Secretary as a record may have been broken during the season and not be current in this booklet.

Several records were broken last season and we look forward to some more this year.
